### 3. Tuition and other fees:

- Tuition per semester: NT\$49,234
- Accommodation fee per semester: NT\$12,500
- Other expenses borne by students: Student Safety Insurance (NT\$400/semester), Foreign Student Health Insurance (NT\$3,600 for the first semester in Taiwan), National Health Insurance (NT\$4,956/semester, starting from the second semester in Taiwan), Accommodation Deposit (NT\$1,000), Alien Resident Certificate (NT\$1,000/year), Work Permit (NT\$100/6 months), Health Examination Fee (NT\$600/time)

### 4. Scholarships and conditions:

- One-time airfare and administrative fees (up to NT\$12,000).
- First year: Full tuition and miscellaneous fees subsidy.
- Second year (conditions): Preferential subsidy covering 70% of the number of students' full tuition and miscellaneous fees (students in the second year need to pass a joint review of their performance and grades by the school and the company to be eligible for full tuition and miscellaneous fees subsidy).
- The company provides a living allowance of NT\$10,000 per month for the first 17 months after each student's enrollment.
- Recipients of subsidies from the Ministry of Education and companies must serve in Taiwan-based companies for 2 years after graduation.
